- 1 die
- 4 rule summary sheets
- 24 Recipe cards
- 4 Baker cards

Set UD

1. Place all 4 Kitchen cards in a row in the center of the table as the kitchen. For a 3-player game, place the cards with the) icon face up. For a 4-player game, side with the

place the cards with the side with the) icon face up. The maximum number of Bread pieces that can be placed depends on the number of players.

- 2. Shuffle the Recipe cards and form a draw pile. Place the draw pile with the cards face up next to the Kitchen cards.
- 3. Hand out the following items to each player:
- 1 食パン/Sliced Bread Recipe card
- 2 Bread pieces
- 1 rule summary sheet
- 4. The person who wanted to be a baker is the start player. Otherwise, determine the start player in whatever way you like.
- 5. Give the die to the start player.

In the standard rule, Baker cards aren't used.



* Sample set-ups for a 3-player game



Play the game in turns from the start player in clockwise order. Thé current player chooses to perform one of the following actions. Once a player has performed his action, he hands the die to the next player to take turn.

a) Work.

- (b) Take Bread piece(s) from the kitchen.
- (c) Pass the turn.

(a) Work. You can place Bread piece(s) on a Kitchen card to perform an action according to the placed location. If you place 2 Bread pieces at once, you may receive a bonus effect your action. Each Kitchen card has the maximum number of Bread pieces that can be placed on it as specified

by the number of (icons.

For example, if a Kitchen card has 3 icons and 3 Bread pieces are already placed on it, you cannot place another Bread piece on that Kitchen card.

(1) Recipe Order When you place a Bread piece on the レシピ/Recipe Order Kitchen card, resolve the effect in the following order: - Draw 2 Recipe cards from the draw pile. - Choose up to 1 card from the 2 Recipe cards

- you've drawn and place it face up in your recipe placement area.
- In the recipe discard area, discard in the Recipe card you didn't place in your recipe placement area.

If the draw pile runs out, shuffle all the Recipe cards

- in the discard pile to form a new draw pile.
- You can place up to 2 unfinished Recipe cards in your recipe placement area. You cannot place 3 cards, but you can replace the Recipe cards in your recipe placement area with other ones.
- If you draw Recipe cards but don't want either of them, you may discard them without receiving any.

<If you place 2 Bread pieces> You can draw 3 Recipe cards from the draw pile, although you can receive only 1 of them to place in your Recipe placement area.

(2) Preparation When you place a Bread piece on the 下ごしらえ/Preparation Kitchen card, resolve the action in the following order: - Choose the bread to prepare from among the bread(s) in your Pacing placement area

- in your Recipe placement area.Roll the die. If your die roll result achieves the target point specified on the Recipe card, your preparation has However, if your die roll result is "1", your attempt has failed regardless of the target point

for the recipe.



- * If you don't have any incomplete Bread Recipe card After completing the preparation for your recipe, rotate that Recipe card sideways to differentiate it from a Recipe card for which the preparation hasn't finished.



< If you place 2 Bread pieces> Your die roll result is increased by "1".

(3) Baking When you place a Bread piece on the 焼き上げ/Baking Kitchen card, resolve the action in the following order: - Choose thee bread to bake from among the Bread Begine card(s) in your recipe placeme

- Bread Recipe card(s) in your recipe placement area. Roll the die. If your die roll result achieves the target point specified on the Recipe card, your bread is

angle provide specific of the receipe card to the 職人魂/Craftsmanship side. However, if your die roll result is "1", your attempt has failed regardless of the target point for the recipe.

* If you don't have any completely prepared Bread Recipe card in your recipe placement area, you cannot place any Bread piece on the "Baking" Kitchen card.



< If you place 2 Bread pieces> Your die roll result is increased by "1".

[How to Use 職人魂/Craftsmanship Cards] Using the 職人魂/Craftsmanship card(s) formed by baking bread, you can try making more challenging bread. If you place Bread piece(s) on the 下ごしらえ/Preparation" or 焼き上げ/Baking" Kitchen card and roll the die, you can use 職人魂/Craftsmanship to increase the die roll result by "1" , result by "1"

You can use multiple 職人魂/Craftsmanship cards at once, but you need to place a Bread piece on the 休日/Day Off Kitchen card (described later) to turn the 職人魂/Craftsmanship cards back into the unused state.

Rotate used 職人魂/Craftsmanship cards sideways to differentiate them from unused ones.

(4) Day Off
When you place a Bread piece on the 休日/Day Off Kitchen card, resolve the action in the following order:
Turn all 職人魂/Craftsmanship cards back into the unused state.

- * You cannot place 2 Bread pieces on the "Day Off" Kitchen card.

(b) Take Bread piece(s) from the kitchen.

Take up to 2 Bread pieces from the kitchen. However, you can take the Bread piece(s) from only 1 Kitchen card at a time. Thus, if all Kitchen cards have only 1 Bread piece on

and kitchen cards have only 1 bread piece on each of them, you can increase your Bread piece only 1 piece even if you choose
(b) Take Bread piece(s) from the kitchen."
Also, note that you can keep only up to 2 Bread pieces.
You can choose "(b) Take Bread piece(s) from the kitchen."
when you have 1 Bread piece, but you can take only if a piece is such a care. only 1 Bread piece in such a case.

(c) Pass the turn. * If you don't have anything to do, pass your turn.

Find of the Game The game ends when one of the players completely bake 5 Recipe cards.

After the end condition is met, have the players up to the player before the start player take turns, so that all players take the same number of turns. After the player before the start player completes his turn, end the game and calculate the scores.

Scoring

Add up the points stated on the baked breads. The player who achieves the highest score wins the game. Breads that haven't been baked completely don't count as the score. In case of a tie, among the top players, the player who has baked the most various types of bread wins. If that's also a tie, the tie players share the victory.

🌮 [Baker cards]

At the setup, hand out 1 Baker card to each player randomly. Baker cards have special abilities stated on them. These abilities can be used any time without a limit. We recommend using Baker cards for a 3-player game.

ベテラン職人/Experienced Baker:

Increases the die roll result by 1 for "Preparation". If the die roll result is "1", the attempt fails.

炎の職人/Fiery Baker: Increases the die roll result by 1 for "Baking".

知識の職人/Knowledgeable Baker:

When placing Bread piece(s) on the "Recipe Order" Kitchen card, you can draw 3 Recipe cards and take 2 of them for 1 Bread piece or draw 4 Recipe cards and take 2 of them for 2 Bread pieces.

カの職人/Powerful Baker:

You can turn back 1 職人魂/Craftsmanship card to the unused state at the start of your turn.
